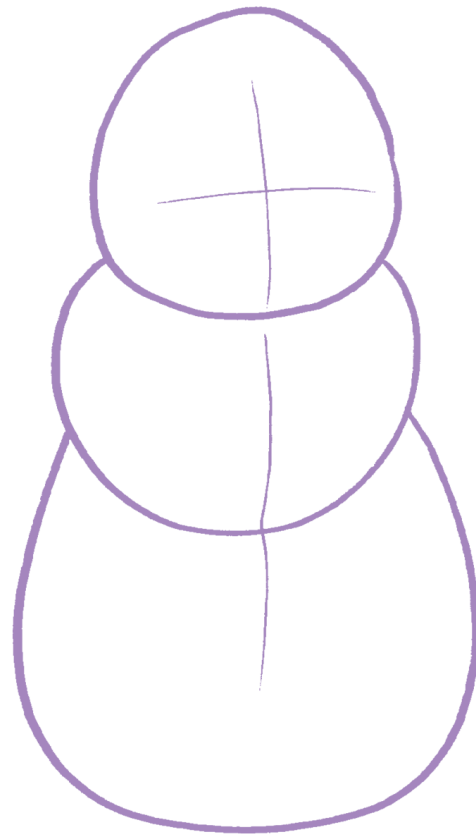


Emperor Penguin Chick

The emperor penguin chick cannot fly when born and has very soft gray feathers called down. At about six weeks old, the emperor penguin chick will join other chicks in a crèche (a place where chicks are taken care of during the day, by other adult penguins). As the chick grows older, its feathers turn black and white.

1 Penguins start out life pretty fluffy. First, sketch out these three shapes. It will look like a snowman.



2 Next, sketch in the wings and rough shapes for his eyes, beak, and toes.

3 Now, add some detail to its face, then some pencil marks to indicate its fluffy feathers.



4 Add some shading and this little penguin is all set to waddle around.
